Please review some additional details before you complete and sign your CSA agreement:

- * The 2023 Summer CSA season is set to run from June 15th through October 28th 2023.
- * Payment in full prior to the start of the season is appreciated, but payment options are available.
- * Membership is a commitment for the full season, there are no refunds once the season has begun.
- * One flex week per season is available for weekly members but we ask for one week notice for a flex week off. The flex week can be made up at the end of the season.
- * Half shares will be assigned a biweekly schedule and have the option of a flexible schedule.
- * Members are responsible for assuring that their share is picked up. If you miss a week without notice and cannot arrange for someone to pick up your share, your share will be redistributed.
- * Occasional location switches are available upon request and with enough prior notice.
- * Farming contains risks beyond our control. We cannot guarantee the quantity or availability of any specific vegetables.

For the 2023 season, we're partnering with Main Street Farms in Cortland again for our 4th year. Shared Roots Farm co-owner Bret is managing the certified organic farm operation that covers both Main Street Farms and Shared Roots Farm. The bulk of the veggies will be grown at Main Street Farms where there is more space and equipment. A few long season crops are grown here at Shared Roots, as well as most of the high tunnel crops, including tomatoes, peppers, eggplant and spring/winter greens.
